





The book list is a synthesis of Oxford and Punjab Curriculum and Textbook Board syllabus in order to keep pace with the modern education.



The presence of politicians and cricketing heroes at the Annual sports and games day is a source of inspiration for the budding sportsmen. A Sports Day provides them moments to cherish.









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ABRAHAM LINCOLN'S

LETTER TO HIS SON'S HEADMASTER

"He will have to learn, I know, that all men are not just, and all men are not true. But teach him also that for every scoundrel, there is a hero, that for every selfish politician, there is a dedicated leader".

"Teach him that for every enemy, there is a friend. It will take time, I know: but teach him, if you can that a dollar earned is far more valuable than five found... teach him to learn to lose and also to enjoy winning, steer him away from envy, if you can. teach him if you can, the wonder of books... but also give him quite time to ponder over the eternal mystery of birds in the sky, bees in the sun, and flowers in a green hill-side".

"In school teach him that it is far more honorable to fail than to cheat... Teach him to have faith in his own ideas, even if everyone tells him they are wrong. Teach him to be gentle with people and tough with the tough. Try to give my son the strength not to follow the crowd when everyone is getting on the bandwagon. Teach him to listen to all men but teach him also to filter all he hears on a screen of truth and take only the good that comes through".

"Teach him if you can, how to laugh when he is sad... Teach him there is no shame in tears. Teach him to scoff at cynics and to beware of too much sweetness. Teach him to sell his brawn and brain to the highest bidders; but never to put a price tag on his heart and soul. Teach him to close his ears to a howling mob... and to stand and fight if he thinks he's right".

"Treat him gently; but do not cuddle him because only the test of fire makes fine steel. Let him have the courage to be impatient... let him have the patience to be brave. Teach him always to have sublime faith in mankind".

This is a big order; but see what you can do... he is such a fine little fellow, my son...

Admission Procedure

Por admission to any class in Unique Junior School, an Admission Test comprising the following subjects is held.

- UrduMaths
- EnglishGeneral KnowledgeNazra
- Pass marks i.e. 40% marks in the admission test (in each of the above mentioned subjects) are necessary for the admission.
- All Hafiz-e-Quran students are exempted from admission test up to 8th class. However, it is ensured that a student seeking admission is able to read and write both English and Urdu. In addition, he/ she must be familiar with the basics of mathematics i.e. addition, subtration, multiplication, division, etc.

Age Limit

We offer admission to the children between the age group of 3+ to 10+ years. Our age-wise division of the Junior classes is as follows:

Fee Refund Policy

If a new student leaves the institution within six working days after getting admission, he/she shall be refunded 100% fee including A/C charges. In case, the students/ parents do not turn up to receive the fee refund, the amount of the fee refunded may be sent to the parents by money order after informing them through telephonic communication.

In case, a student decides to leave the institution after attending school for more than six working days or full month (before depositing the next month fee), he/she shall be refunded Admission Fee and Security only.

Rules & Regulations


Parents/ students are advised to study the rules and regulations carefully. They must adhere to these rules in all respects so it is obligatory on all to abide by these rules. Violation of these rules may lead to the expulsion of a student from the school.

- All students are instructed to reach the school well in time.
- No student shall be allowed to attend classes without proper school uniform except Playgroup.
- The person who escorts a child from school should show the school I.D card on the school gate for security reasons.
- A system generated "absent message" will be sent to the parents of absent students.
- In case of any inconvenience or inquiry, students are advised to consult their respective class In-charges.
- The school premises, classrooms and surroundings must be kept neat and clean.
- Students are strictly prohibited to write on walls and whiteboards.
- Students should not be allowed to take leave without any specific reason or emergency. The leave application form must bear the signatures of both the parent and the Class In-charge.
- The attendance of the student in the Class Test in compulsory. In case of absence, the student shall have to appear in the Supplementary Test of the same subject.
- The minimum pass percentage in monthly 40% and term tests is 33%.
- Students are given Encouragement Scholarships and class position scholarships.

- Students must participate in co-curricular activities to groom their personality.
- Students must focus on moral and ethical values.
- Students are advised to pay rapt attention to the teachers' lecture in the class.
- Discipline in the school premises must be maintained by all means.
- Instruction and any notices issued by the Principal or the Vice Principal should be followed strictly.
- The Clerical Staff, Security Guard and the Office Management Staff render commendable services to the students.

 Therefore, they deserve due regard from the students.
- Students and their parents are not allowed to register any complaint against the management and the faculty to any official authority or agency regarding the matters related to this institution without the written permission of the Principal.
- The last date for the deposit of fee is the 5th of each month. In case of failure to deposit the fee within due date, Rs.30/- per day will be fined. The student's name will be struck off due to nonpayment of dues.
- Female students are not allowed to wear jewellery during school hours.
- Extension in fee can only be granted twice in a session with prior approval of the principal.
- Fee can be refunded according to the "Fee Refund Policy" prescribed by the institution that is available at the school office.
